# Geology Walks through Time in Shropshire

As part of CPRE's national centenary celebrations, join us for six fascinating 'walks through time' between April and September visiting important geological sites in the county of Shropshire



**Walks programme (all walks start at 10.30 for 11)**

**1: Sunday 19 April: PreCambrian - Pontesford & Earl's Hill**

**2: Saturday 16 May: Ordovician - Stiperstones & the Bog**

**3: Sunday 21 June: Silurian - Wenlock Edge**

**4: Saturday 18 July: Devonian & Carboniferous - Titterstone Clea**

**5: Sunday 16 August: Carboniferous - Llanymynech Rocks**

**6: Saturday 19 September: Permo-Triassic - Nesscliffe Hill & the Cliffe**

All walks start at 10.30 for 11 and aim to be around 2 hours in length. Most will be around 3 to 4 miles in length. After the walks, there will be an option to continue discussions over lunch at a local venue.
